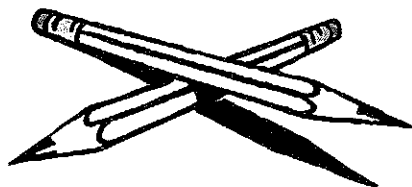
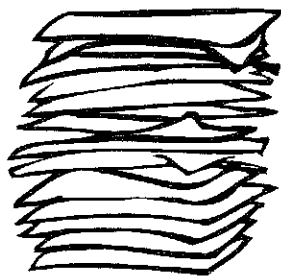


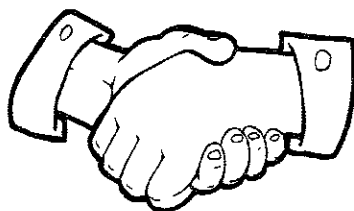
Be the **STAR** of today's worship service. After the service is over, complete this checklist:

- ☐ Help put away communion elements

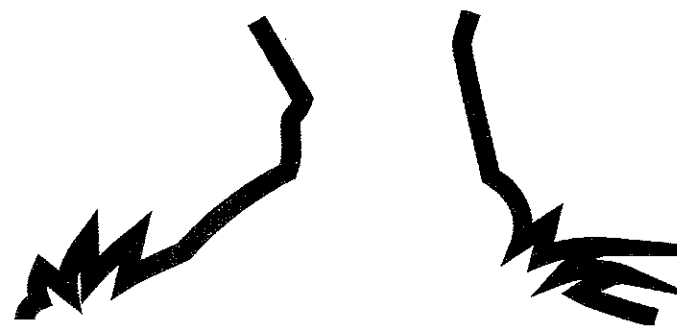


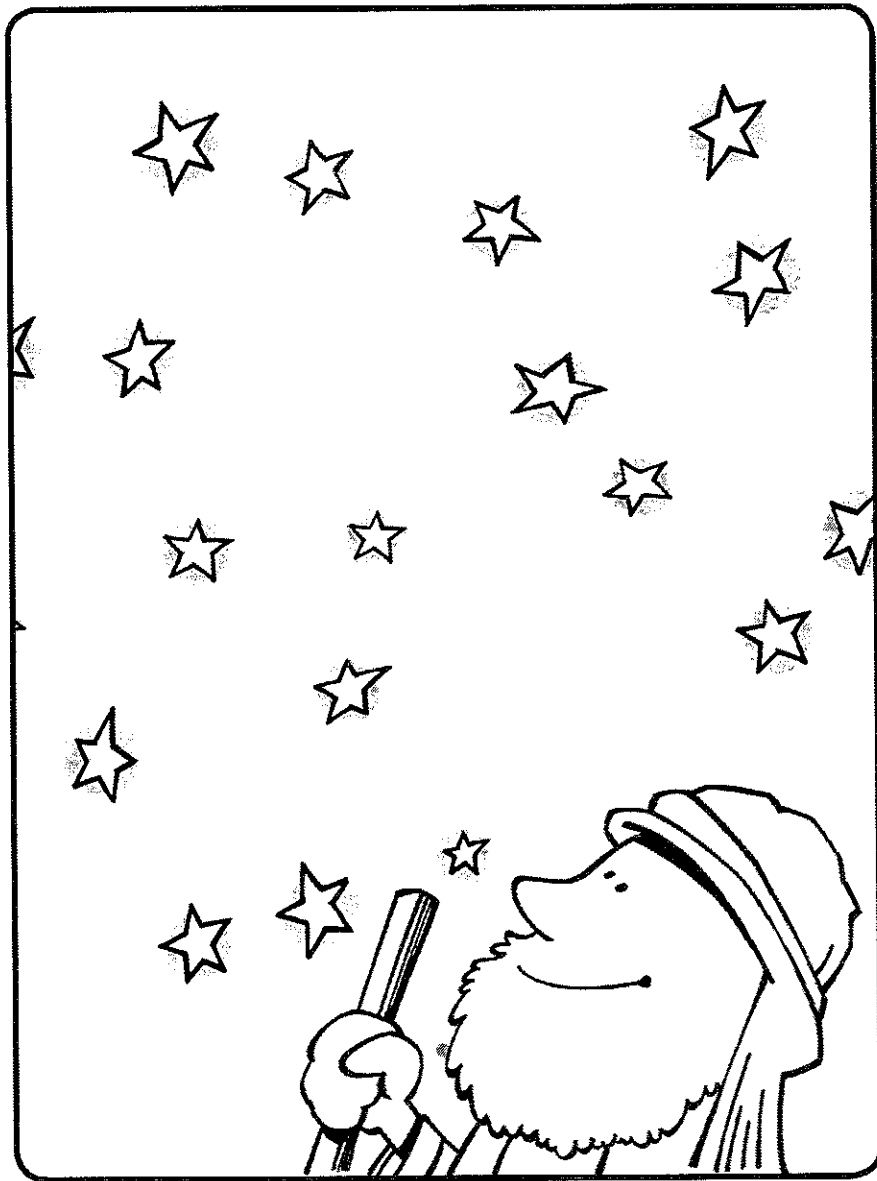
## PRE-READER

Below is a tree trunk. Add branches by tracing your hand. Line up your wrist with the trunk and spread your fingers wide!

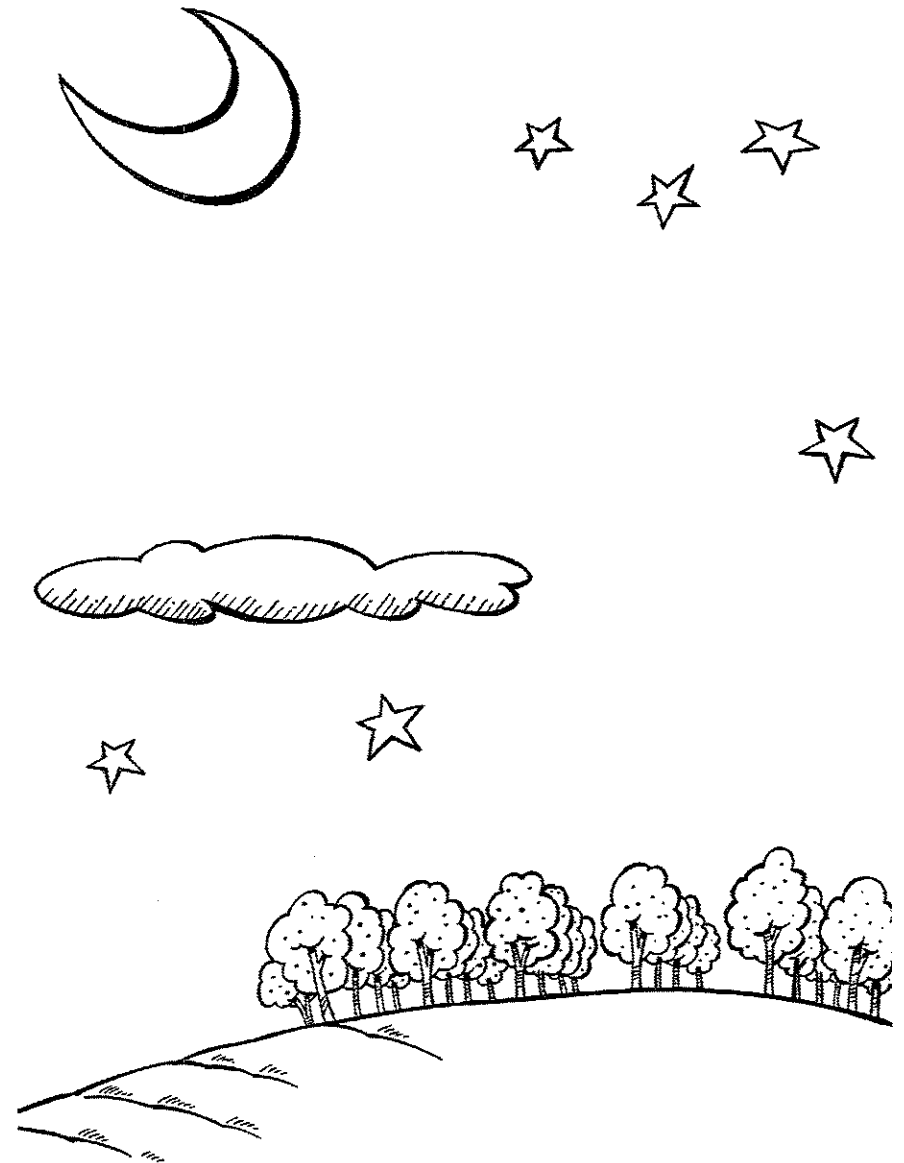




Abram looked up at the stars and saw

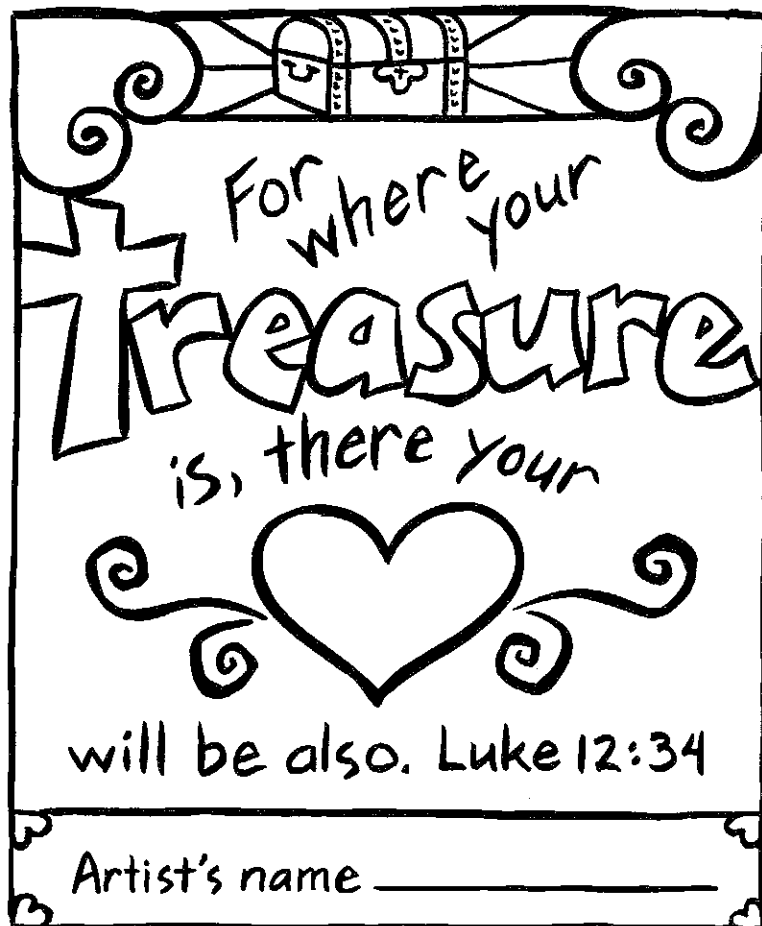
Draw a star for each member of your family
