
Can you find a baptismal font at your church?

Draw it in the space below. Then draw your face and mark a cross on your forehead to remember that you are one of God's children.








- Today is the 11th Sunday after Pentecost.



Why worship on Sunday?

Christians worship on Sunday because it is the first day of the week, the day Jesus rose from the dead. Maybe we should call it Sonday to remember God's Son, Jesus!

What is the sabbath?
