Welcome to worship. Flags often give the message of freedom. Use these flags to decode Jesus' message to his disciples and to us in today's gospel reading.



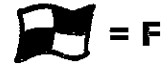

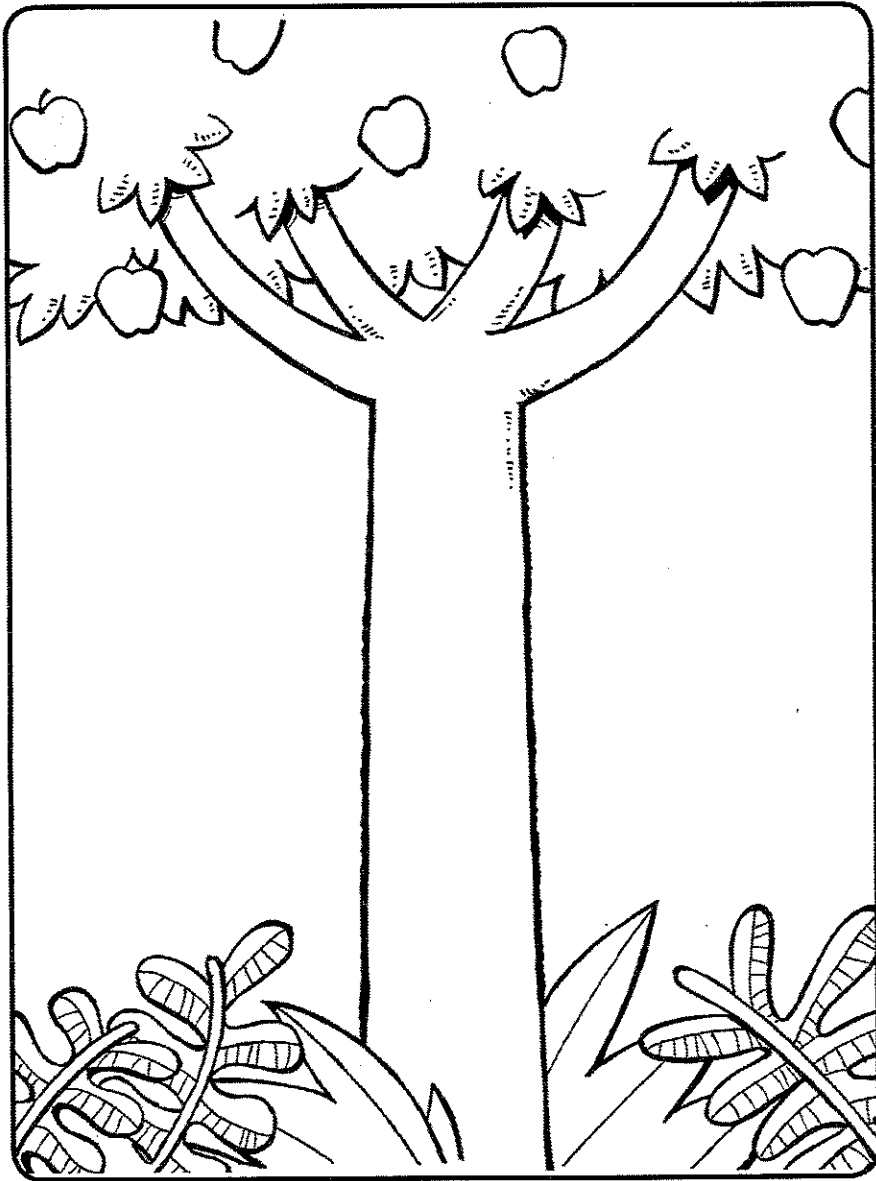
Pentecost 3
