


Give a paper heart to someone who takes care of you.

Draw a one-of-a-kind person sitting near you.





God wants us to welcome everyone to worship. In the picture below, circle all of the things that help people worship.






How does your church make sure everyone feels welcome?

God's family is so big! You are part of God's family. Everyone who is at worship with you today is part of God's family too. Count how many members of God's family are at worship today.


Write down a tally of the number of people you count. See directions below on how to make tallies.
