Circle six shells hidden in this picture.






Fun fact: The dye Lydia used to make purple cloth came from shellfish that live in the Mediterranean Sea.









- Today is the 6th Sunday of Easter.




Lydia said to Paul, "Tell me more about Jesus! I want to learn everything I can about the Son of God!"
